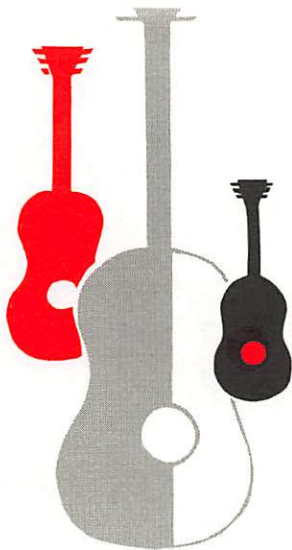

Thanks for your letter detailing your reception of WGUS (AM), and this letter will serve to verify your reception of WGUS (AM), on 21 January 1975 from 0103 to 0107AM EST.

WGUS (AM) was on the air that morning for our monthly frequency check, with our measuring service in Greenville, South Carolina.

WGUS (AM) operates with a daytime power of 1000 watts, feeding a 365 foot tower. Sidemounted at the top of the tower is our FM antenna, and lower, also sidemounted, is our two-way radio antenna.

The transmitter is a Collins 20V2, which uses a pair of 4-400's modulated by a pair of 4-400's.
