We'll confirm your listener report of April 2, 1979 of hearing KBCN at your location. KYW didn't shut down as they usually do, thus causing unusual condx. The boys are already cooking on another test, tho.

KBCN moved from a kw at 910 in Sept 77. We use an STL to feed and control our remote transmitter which is also our standby FM site for sister KBXL. The plant consists of a Sparta 710, an RCA - BTA-10H aux and a BTA-1R for PSA and a kw. The antenna is a tall quarter, 290' with an extensive ground on a high spot in the countryside near Star, Idaho. Audio processing is the new Inovonics 231 MAP II.
