Thank you for your "DX" reception letter of March 9, 1977 received on March 12th.

WLBH operates with 5,000 Watts on 1170 KHz with a Directional Antenna consisting of four towers in line 160/340 degrees true. Our major lobe throws most of our signal Southeast since we must protect a station on 1170 at Davenport, Ia.


We sign-on during March at 6 AM and sign-off at 6 PM. WLBH is licensed to operate Daytime Only by the FCC.

Your reception report checks with our program log of Mar. 3 for the period of the day from 6:00 AM CST to 6:05 AM.

At the above time of the day, WWVA was operating non-direction with 50,000 Watts on 1170 and KVOO was operating with 50,000 Watts directional that early in the morning. At sun-rise in Tulsa, KVOO goes Non-Dir.
