Thank you very much for the reception report. I am glad to know that we are getting out well in your direction. You may be able to get us for a little longer this month as our sign-on has advanced to 7:45am.

Our equipment includes a Collins 300-J transmitter, and a two tower directional array. The programming for both Wgom (AM) and WMRI (our FM) is supplied by two Harris System 90 automations. On FM, we have a Harris FM-10-H3 transmitter and a Jampro 12 bay antenna which develop 50,000 watts ERP circular polarization.

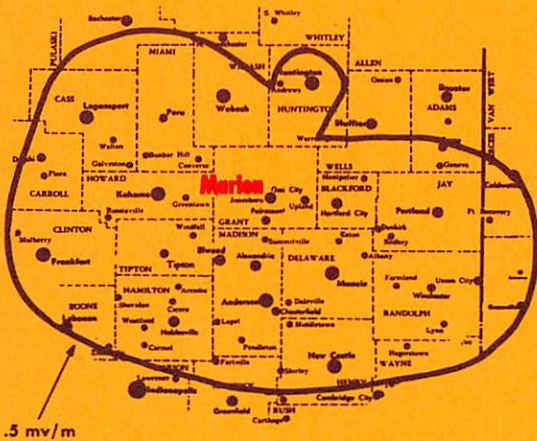
Please feel free to correspond with me if you have any additional information or questions concerning WGOM. Once again, it was a pleasure to read your report. Thanks much.
