This confirms your reception of WNDE - 1260 KHZ between 3:45 AM & 3:59 AM
on September 12, 1978

WNDE operates with a power of 5000 watts. Our daytime antenna is non-directional. Our nighttime antenna is directional with two main lobes at 171 and 351 degrees, we also have two smaller lobes at 81 and 261 degrees. When you received us we were operating on the Directional antenna.

Our main transmitter is a RCA BTA-5H and our alternate main transmitter is a RCA BTA-5U2. Both transmitters operate with an output power of 5000 watts. We were operating on the (see below) transmitter when you received us.

We changed our call letters to WNDE in August of 1973. Our former call letters were WFBM. WFBM was the first commercial radio station in the state of INDIANA.

We also operate FM station WFBQ on 94.7 MHz with an effective radiated power of 52,000 watts.
