Dear Mr. Lindblade:

We are pleased to acknowledge receipt of your report of January 19, 1975 from 2346 thru 2400 CST at which time you quite accurately logged programming from K S A L.

North

K S A L operates with a full time power output of 5,000 watts, using non-directional antenna days and a four element directional array nights. Normal hours of operation are from 0530 through 2400 C.S.T. week days and starting at 0655 on Sundays.

K S A L first went on the air May 28 1937 with 100 watts of power, later increased to 250 watts, then 1000/500, then 1000 watts and full 5,000 watts in April of 1949.

Here's hoping you have many interesting hours DXing on the radio waves.
