Dear Mr. Lindblade:

This letter is to confirm your reception report of March 14, 1977. Thank you for the report. KLEX is located about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Lexington, Missouri on US highway 24.

The station was hand built and licensed by a local man in 1956. At present, the station equipment consists of a hand built Gates Gates-way audio console which feeds a homebrew limiter that in turn drives a Gates BC 250 T transmitter. Our antenna is a quarter wave series fed vertical 145 feet high. As you know, our output is 250 watts daytime. We also have a pre-sunrise authority allowing us to sign on early with 194 watts. Our frequency is 1570 kilohertz.

In 1970 a sister FM station was added as KLEX-FM. This was later changed to KBEK. KBEK's License is class A, allowing 3000 watts effective radiated power. Its frequency is 106.3 on MHz.

About 1971, the station was sold to KLEX Incorporated who are the present owners.
