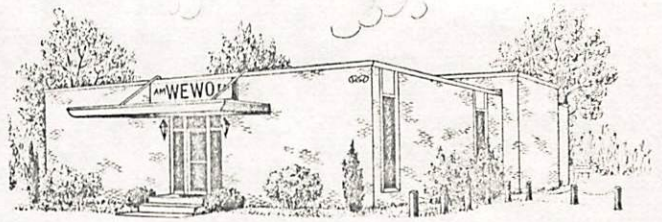

**Dear Rolland,**

We here at WEWO are happy to confirm your reception report of our station on Feb. 23, 1976 at 3:46 AM EST.

WEWO is owned by Curtis & Associates who acquired the station in 1969. The station first signed on in 1947 as a 1000 watt daytimer. In 1956 authorization to operate at 5000 watts during non-critical hours was obtained from the FCC.

Our transmitting equipment consists of a 1947 Raytheon RA-1000 transmitter using 833A's for finals and a homemade linear amplifier using a 3CX20,000 H3tube. The linear has a power gain of 20 so we use a power cut-back on the RA-1000 when operating at 5000 watts. During 1000 watt operation, only the RA-1000 transmitter is used. Our station is non-directional in both modes of operation.

Enclosed you will find a reception verification card and a rate card which has a small coverage map on it.
