

I would like to confirm your reception of KOGA Radio on the 5th of March, 1976 from 0001 to 0012 while we were operating in our non directional mode. Shortly thereafter, we switched to our directional mode and since our pattern is not orientated Eastward, that is probably when you lost us. The different types of tones that you were hearing other than 1000 cps were probably a result of hyterodyning of your receiver with ~~our~~ ^{other} carriers on 930 KHz. Good luck with your DXing in the future.
