Dear Sir;

It is my pleasure to respond to your AM DX report of reception of our signal on Jan. 6, 1979.

This was our regular monthly external frequency-measuring check. As our service is located in Austin, Texas; (some 300 miles distant), we use our 1 Kw power for this check.

Our Normal hours of operation are from 5:30am to 11pm daily; with night time power of 250w and daytime power of 1 Kw.

Our transmitting antenna is 209', series-fed, non-directional, with an almost circular pattern of approximately 100 miles radius. Primary coverage is approximately 60 miles.

Location is half way between Abilene and Lubbock, or just inside the intersection of the southern extension of the Texas-Oklahoma boundary and the eastward extension of the southern New Mexico boundary.

Incidentally, our rig is a RCA BTA-1R1, with 4-400A modulators and finals.

Many thanks for your DX report, and my apologies for the non-reception of your April 1976 report. It is always nice to hear from those who take the time to write.
