Thank you for your reception report of 2-9-76.
Your log is in agreement with WSPT's program log on the date
and time of your reception except for WISN 569 not 5.

WSPT AM transmits from sunrise to sunset with a power of
1000 watts, nondirectional, from a 400 foot guyed, series fed
Andrews tower. Our AM transmitter is a Gates BC-1T, operating
on 1010 KHz.

WSPT FM transmits from sunrise to midnight local time with an
effective radiated power of 50 thousand watts, vertically and
horizontally polarized, from an eleven bay ring antenna mounted
atop our AM tower. Our FM transmitter is a Gates FM-10H
operating on 97.9 MHz.

Thanks again for your report, and let this letter verify your
reception of WSPT Am on 2-9-76, at a time
between 7:00 to 7:00:30 AM CST.
