Dear Rolland,

Because we get so many requests for QSL's between Radio and TV (about 35 a week) I seldom have time to reply with a personal note.

However, since we just topped the 47 country and all 50 state mark since we went 50 kw in 1976, it has come to my attention that many "DX'rs" might be wanting to log us and get QSL cards...especially those living in our deep null that our nighttime pattern has toward Boston.

Noting the NRC letterhead, and being a Ham and somewhat of a DX'r myself, I thought you might be able to further the "cause" by dropping a note to the NRC for one of their future newsletters.

We run audio Proofs-of-Performance every November and June in the NON-Directional mode for from 2 to 4 hours between the hours of midnight and 4:00AM, Mountain time. During most of this time, WBZ is off.

We do this without too much knowledge in advance of which weekend we will use, but at least that may help narrow it down.

KTWO does QSL 100%, but it sometimes takes 90 days or so before we can get to it, so folks should not get worried if they don't see our card too soon.

By the way, we do not need return postage, so save your nickles, guys. We do appreciate report times given for the mountain zone, however, because my secretary does not always understand GMT or other time zones.
