Dear Mr. Lindblade:

Thank you for your reception report of KLEM-FM programming broadcast on August 11, 1975. Your report was correct, and I am pleased to verify your reception of our station with this letter.

KLEM-FM transmits on an assigned carrier frequency of 99.5 MHz with an effective radiated power (ERP) of 47,000 watts. Our transmitter is a Collins type 830E-1 with a rated output of 5000 watts. The antenna is a side-mounted 10-element ring type, also of Collins manufacture, at a height of 290 feet. The tower serves both to radiate our A.M. signal on 1410 kHz and support the separate F.M. antenna.

I welcome future reception reports from both yourself and other DX-ers. All correct reports, of either KLEM-AM or KLEM-FM, will be verified by letter.
