
Thank you for your reception report.

This is to verify that you received signals from WCAL-FM, at 89.3 MHz, between 2350 and 2400 CDT, 1 September, 1975. Our transmission is circularly polarized, with effective radiated power of 100 kW, from an antenna 400 feet above average terrain.

Incidentally, we have another reception report from Nebraska, for the same brief period, and have been heard recently in Washington, D.C.
