Thank you for your letter of July 22, 1075 and your report of reception of KROA-FM on July 19. We receive reports of reception in the Omaha area from time to time, but generally from listeners with more elaborate antennas than yours. The receiving Conditions can undoubtedly be attributed to heavy cloud conditions in the area. In fact, KROA had returned to the air when you were listening just a short time after having sustained considerable lightning damage.

Your report corresponds to our log of program from 1.30pm CDT to 1.45pm CDT, July 19, 1975.

For your information KROA radiates 100KW ERP at an antenna height of 498 feet. Hours of operation are from 6am until Midnight. A coverage map enclosed per your request. The circle indicates 1000 microvolt contour.
