We are pleased to verify your reception of WSCI on June 19, 1975 at 9:20am EDT during which time Overseas Assignment was being broadcast. We can also verify that at 9:30am EDT "Public Radio for Coastal South Carolina This is WSCI, Charleston" was broadcast.

Our station operates within sight of the Atlantic Ocean from a tower height of 540 feet with a horizontal and vertical effective radiated power of 100,000 watts. To hear us in Nebraska on rabbit ears you evidently received a perfect skip.

We operate WEPR Greenville, South Carolina from a height above average terrain of 1200 feet with the same radiated power at 90.1 mHz. Beginning late August of this year WMPR Sumter, also at 1200 feet with the same power, will join our service at 88.1 mHz.
