Dear Sir:

I am enclosing a copy of a report of my reception of WDIG as received on October 1, 1952. I fear that my original report of that date must have been lost or misplaced, as I have never received a reply. I would like very much to receive a verification of my reception of WDIG if this report agrees with your station log and would appreciate any assistance that you can give me in obtaining this confirmation. Thank you very much.

Program details: Central Standard Time

0352 A.M. "Good morning, this is WDIG. WDIG on air for regular monthly frequency check. WDIG, 1450 kcs, 250 watts, WDIG." Selection.

0354 $\frac{1}{2}$ "This is Radio Station WDIG. WDIG is operating on a frequency of 1450 kcs. (Interference from station testing with tone). Selection.

0357 $\frac{1}{2}$ "This is WDIG, William-Dog-I...-George, Dothan, Alabama operating on a frequency of 1450 kcs for our regular frequency check program. WDIG, William-Dog-I...-George, operating on a frequency of 1450 kcs with power of 250 watts. This is our regular monthly frequency check." Selection.

0402 "This is Radio Station WDIG, William-Dog-Ida-George. WDIG is operating this morning on assigned frequency of 1450 kcs. This is our regular frequency check, first Wednesday morning." Selection.

0405 "This is Radio Station WDIG located at Dothan, Alabama. WDIG has been operating on 1450 kcs with 250 watts. This is our regular monthly frequency check. Now leave the air to return at our regularly scheduled time."

Your signals were R-4, S-9. There was considerable static and fading. There was considerable interference thruout the test transmission from other stations on the frequency. The weather was fair with the moon bright and the temperature about 50°. My receiver was a Hammarlund H-129X using a 115 foot East-West antenna.

Hope that I may have the pleasure of hearing from you and receiving a confirmation of my reception of WDIG. I am enclosing return postage for your convenience in replying. Thank you again for your cooperation. Do you have any active amateur radio operators on the staff at WDIG?
