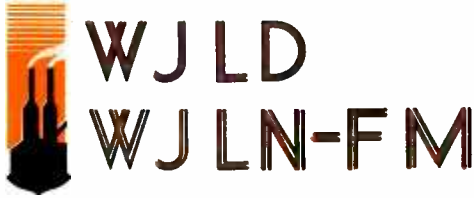

Dear Norm,

Thank you very much for your report of reception of WJLD, from 0222 to 0254 CST on January 10, 1955. Your report is correct. Please except this letter as a VERIFICATION of WJLD, Homewood, Alabama.

WJLD was originally located in Bessemer, Alabama; but on New Years day 1953 WJLD changed transmitter and studio location to Homewood, Alabama.

It may interest you to know that WJLD's transmitter is a Collins 300-G and the studios are all RCA equipped. The tower is 300 feet high being shunt fed. The pattern is non-directional.

So far, we have received 43 reports from the United States, 1 from Canada, and 5 from New Zealand. Man, I didn't think we'd get out that far.

Thanks again for your report and here's wishing you the best of the better brand of DX in the future. See you at the convention.
