U.S.A. from 4.07. A.M. to 5.00. A.M...... E.S T. on .....

For your information, we are no longer using F.Q.N. as call letters. Our indication is now "Ici Radio Saint Pierre, Territoire des Iles Saint Pierre et Miquelon. We are operating every night on 670 kilocycles (Broadcast band) from 7.30 to 8 PM. EST with 250 watts power.
