Received your DX report of December 12, 1947, and thank you very much. We were on the air from 3:00 to 3:15 A. M., C.S.T., which is our regular frequency test broadcast time, the second Friday of each month. We modulate our carrier with a 600 CPS tone with station identification every two minutes. Our frequency is 1230 KC, and we're operating & W.E. model 310 B, using 6-242 C'S push-pull parallel in the final. Our present night time power is 100 watts, 250 daytime, and at the present time am using a three wire flat top antenna, 75 feet high, however, come Spring and the thaw, we intend to erect a vertical, and go 250 day and night.

Thanks again for your letter and comments, and we invite any further reports.
