Thank you for your letter of Nov. 6, 1947.
I am very happy that you heard our Test program which we had
on the air at the time you tuned us in.

Our log shows that on Thurs. Morn. Nov. 6th
we were on the air from 1;30 AM to 2;43 AM for the purpose
of making a Frequency Measurement check and to determine the
condition of our audio and Transmitting equipment, and we used
various audio notes from 200 to 4000 cycles. We signed off at
2;41 AM and our carrier was off at 2;43 AM.

Again I want to thank you for your interest,
and if you ever hear us again on one of our test programs I
would appreciate it very much if you would let me know also
the condition of the reception. Your information was very com-
plete. At various times we receive letters from different parts
of the country saying they have heard our test programs, and it
makes us very happy to hear from the boys. If you are ever in
