As a matter of coincidence, we were being monitored by our station manager in Teaneck, N.J. at the identical time that you had tuned us in. Teaneck is a distance of about 100 miles from us and at the time of monitoring, a portable was being used.

Our equipment consists of a Collins 300-G 250/100 watt transmitter. At the time you heard us, we were operating on ~~100~~ 250 watts. The rest of our equipment is a combination of Collins and General Radio.
