Refer your letter of August 3rd, 1946. Thank you very much for writing us and telling of our reception up in Glastonbury. This will confirm that your enclosure of "Program details" checks with our logs here at W O L F.


W O L F signs on the air at 6:00 AM every morning but Sunday when we sign on at 8:00 AM. Sign off time is 2:00 AM the following morning every day except Sunday when we sign off at 1:00 AM. All times Eastern Daylight Time.

W O L F is a Mutual station and operates with a power of 250 watts output. Vertical quarter wave antenna, 155 feet over all length. Collins transmitting equipment and RCA studio equipment.

We hope that you will give us further reports in the future. Our intentions are to construct a "distance coverage graph" and all reports are welcome.

Thanking you again for your acknowledgement of receipt of our signals.
