I had the pleasure of tuning your station, KRUL, this morning while you were conducting a test transmission on 1340 kilocycles. I would like very much to receive a verification of my reception of KRUL if this report agrees with your station log.

Program details: Pacific Standard Time.

0130 A.M. "Test program is recorded. Time in 15 seconds will be 1:30."

Classical selection.

0139 "This is KRUL, K-R-U-L, in Corvallis, Ore., owned and operated by Pacific States Radio Co. Operate on 1340 kcs. for test with Pt. Reyes, Cal. Music on the program is recorded. In 10 seconds, will be 20 minutes before 1 o'clock, -2 o'clock."

Selection.

0145 "This is KRUL, Corvallis, Ore., owned and operated by Pacific States Radio Co., operate on 1340 kcs. with 250 watts by F.C.C. Music is recorded."

Your signals were R-5, S7-9. There was considerable fading and slight static. There was occasional interference from other stations on the channel. The weather was fair with the stars bright and the temperature about 38°. My receiver was a Hammarlund HQ-129X using a 115 foot East-West antenna.

Hope that this report may be of interest to you and your staff and that I may have the pleasure of receiving a confirmation of my reception of KRUL. Thank you very much.
