This will serve to verify your report of reception of our signals on 1450 kilocycles -250 watts heard on November 18, 1946 from 106 to 123 AM Eastern Standard time. Your report has been checked with transmitter log and has been found to be correct.

Our transmitter and tower is located 2 miles East of Indiana in a valley. The tower is 150 foot high with a ground system of bare copper wire buried in radial fashion from the base of the tower. The x-mtr is a Western Electric 250 watts Standard broadcast model.
