I wish to acknowledge your letter dated April 12, but first want to apologize for our seemingly laxity. As you probably know, we have been "snowed under" with work the past few weeks and are just now getting caught up.

We are using the Collins 20-T Radio Broadcasting equipment. This gear is designed to operate with 500 or 1000 watts. We operate with 500 watts daytime. The studios are downtown in Victoria and the transmitting equipment is located about one and one-half miles from town. We are using a shunt-fed 200 ft. tower with 240 radials in the ground system. 120 of which are 200 ft and 120 50 ft.
