Dear Mr Maguire:

Am pleased to verify your reception of WLPN on the morning of May 28, 1945 at 1:25 to 1:47 $\frac{1}{2}$ AM eastern war time.

I was running approximately 199 watts into the antenna as measured by the direct method. The antenna is a square type (box type) steel structure 177feet from the ground up composite built(home built)

That was the third attempt to measure the frequency as a local station in Washington interfered the first two attempts.

The weather was clear and warm.

All equipment is Collins through out.
