Thanks very much for your letter of the 12th, telling us about receiving our Test Program on your HQ120X.

Your itemization corresponds perfectly with our records, and you can accept this letter as our verification of it.

It does seem rather unusual that the signal from our 1 KW Auxiliary should get up your way so well, due to the fact that from sunset to sunrise, we are operating on a 3 tower, Directional Antenna, throwing our minimum at NYC., however, due to the fact that there were no other stations on our frequency at that time, probably made the reception possible. Ordinarily, WBNX, NYC, would blanket us in your area.

I enjoyed reading your letter, and imagine that you have had some experience in Hamming, or similar, and that always hits a warm spot, for have operated Amateur W3ECP for 10 years prior to the war, and hope to do so again in the looked-for post war era.

Again, many thanks for your letter, and if you should run across us again, a note would be greatly appreciated.
