This is to verify your report of reception, received this week.

Equipment tests were made Monday, September 9th, by station KFOR on 1370 kilocycles.

Thought you might be interested in data on the station. We're daytime - 6:00 AM to local sunset. We're equipped with a Collins 20V, 1000 watt broadcast transmitter and a 195', aluminum Alpar tower. We started broadcasting on Tuesday, September 10, 1957. Our Grand Opening was on September 21st.

The town of Quincy and surrounding area has an approximate population of 7000. This has largely been due to the recent opening of the Grand Coulee irrigation project.
