Dear Mr. Norman Maguire,

I am deeply pleased with the report I received from you dated October 17. It is gratifying to know that with conditions as you reported at your station were KULE was able to put in an R5 signal. I was on the air also the morning of October 16 conducting tests for my own purpose and have received a report from Lincoln, Neb. which gave me an S-4-5 and an R5 using the same type receiver as you have but with only 20 feet of antenna wire strung up inside the operator's room. I might add that this station is restricted to daylight operation and therefore would not be heard in your locale except during periods of testing which occur after midnight. Our next scheduled test with Point Reyes, Calif. will be conducted the morning of November 21 from 1:00 AM until 1:15 AM.
