I wish to apologize for the delay in answering your verification of reception of KOWB's signal. I have been in the hospital for some time and necessarily have neglected my correspondence.

I have checked the contents of your letter and I am pleased to be able to verify your reception.

For your information regarding Station KOWB, we are using a Collins 300G 250 watt transmitter which operates on a frequency of 1340 KC's. Our studio and audio equipment is also Collins. We are using a wincharger guyed tower slightly less than one-quarter wave length long. Our studio and transmitter equipment are contained um er one roof. The building is of modern type architecture which fits in very nicely with the surroundings here at Laramie.

Station KOWB is owned by local businessmen of Laramie and started operating February 20th. We are affiliated with Mutual Broadcasting System. For your information we are conducting frequency measurements in the future on the first Thursday of each month.
