reporting reception of CHAB Radio.


I checked our Radio log, and am pleased to
verify your reception of CHAB Radio on Nov.
15th, 1961 at 12:39 -1:09 C.D.T.

CHAB operates on 800 kilocycles with a power
of 10,000 watts. Our transmitter is located
in the heart of Southern Saskatchewan, seven
miles west of Moose Jaw.

Canadian Marconi transmitter equipment is used,
there are three towers, and at that time there
would be 2 kilowatts in your direction.
