Dear Murray,


This is to confirm your DX report of August 12, 1959. Thank you very much. We are always glad to get DX correspondence. WJAN is Upper Michigan's most powerful radio station. We are a relatively new station, having commenced regular programming on June 26, 1959 and therefore, are not listed in any of the trade papers.

We have everything in our favor for a good signal. We are on a good frequency, have the best ground system I've ever seen, and of course have 5000 watts. Our ground radials are under water at all times. Our antenna is planted right in the middle of a swamp which is good for the signal, but makes it a little rough on the engineering staff when it comes time to visit the tower.

WJAN operates on a sunrise to sunset schedule and follows a "Top 40" format. We also use a lot of gimmicks and sales promotions and strive for "bang bang" productions.
