Dear Murray:

Thank you very much for your June 27 signal report on KFOR. We have always put a fair signal into Omaha during the daylight hours and are always happy to receive reports that we still do, even tho Omaha is not considered in our trade area.

KFOR transmitter is located at 45th. and Vine street. The power is 250 watts and the antenna is 250 feet high with a ground system of radials 250 feet long every two degrees. The transmitter is remote controlled from the studios which are located on the 8th. floor of the Stuart building in down town Lincoln. The transmitter is a Collins 300-J2 using a pair of 4-125A in the final and a pair as modulators. We also have an RCA BFA-250M transmitter as a standby. This transmitter uses 813's in the final and modulators.
