Dear Murray,

This will serve to verify your report of reception of KNEB the morning of May 4, 1958.

Voice identifications were given during the breaks you mentioned in the tone. If you didn't hear them, I'm sure it was because of interference as we use a Sta-Level in conjunction with our limiter. Program sources can be fed into our mixer as much as 15 DB below normal and still cause full modulation of the transmitter.

Your location is less than ideal for receiving KNEB to say the least. Our night pattern has a null to protect KMA in Shennandoah, Iowa. This results in a minimum amount of signal from KNEB in your direction.
