Dear Mr. Mann:

This letter is in verification of your Reception Report #85.

It is usually the policy of KIBM (AM) and KBIM-FM to require not less than ten minutes of reported time before giving a letter of verification. However, since you very accurately report an unscheduled newscast from KBIM Mobile News Unit Number Two, we feel completely satisfied that KBIM was indeed logged at your station at the reported time.

At the time you report reception, KBIM had not yet mounted the FM antenna on the AM tower. The station was operating with five thousand watts of power. Our pattern is essentially circular since we do not operate with a directional array. We operate a shunt-excited antenna with the slant-line lobe in a direction away from Omaha.

Your reception, then, was truly one of diligent attention on your part and reflects a true interest in your hobby.
