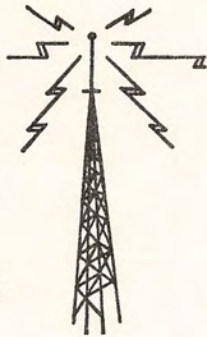

Here are a few facts about our installation that might interest you. We are using a Collins 20v transmitter with a power output of 1000 watts. The Tower is a shunt fed system with a height of 378 feet, the last 54 feet of which is an RCA Pylon for our FM Transmitter.
