In reference to your letter in acknowledgment of our equipment check on Dec. 21st. You stated you were using a National NC-183D receiver, Signal Strength: Meter S/9 plus 5 DB, Antenna: Single wire 106 feet long, E-W. Interference: "A little was heard from other ~~xxx~~ stations underneath you, but not bad!" Temperature 29 degrees. Weather ~~xxx~~ cool and clear. Reception report no. 70.

We are now broadcasting on 1600 kilocycles on 5 kilowatts on daytime only at present. We hope to be on night time soon also.
