Facts about CRC:

Established in 1976 as a joint venture of BBC (United Kingdom) and Deutsche Welle (Germany), programmes in four different languages are broadcast to North and South America and the Caribbean Area. Programmes originate in Europe and are relayed to Antigua via satellite.

Four 250 kW Marconi transmitters, supplied by their own diesel generators, can be switched to a number of dipole arrays to serve the required target area.

Facts about Antigua:

The island of Antigua is part of the Lesser Antilles and is situated at 17°05 N and 61°50 W. Together with its dependencies Barbuda and Redonda it is 440 km<sup>2</sup> in size and its highest elevation is Boggy Peak, rising to 402 meters. The population is approximately 70,000, mainly of African origin. Antigua was discovered by Columbus in 1493 and settled by the English in 1632. It gained independence from the United Kingdom in 1981 but is still part of the Commonwealth.

Antigua is surrounded by white sand beaches, which are protected by coral reefs, thus making it attractive to tourists. The climate is sunny and dry with the tradewinds moderating the heat. Average temperatures vary between 24°C in January/February and 29°C in August/September. The hurricane season and the period of most rainfall is from June to November.
