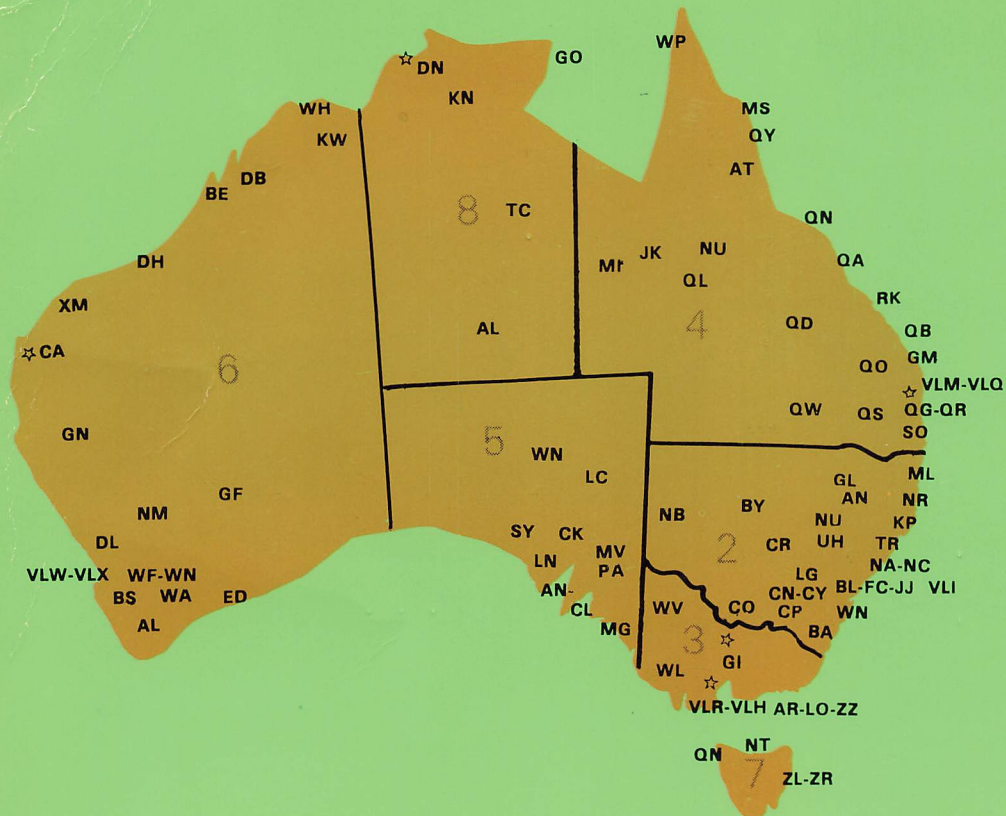

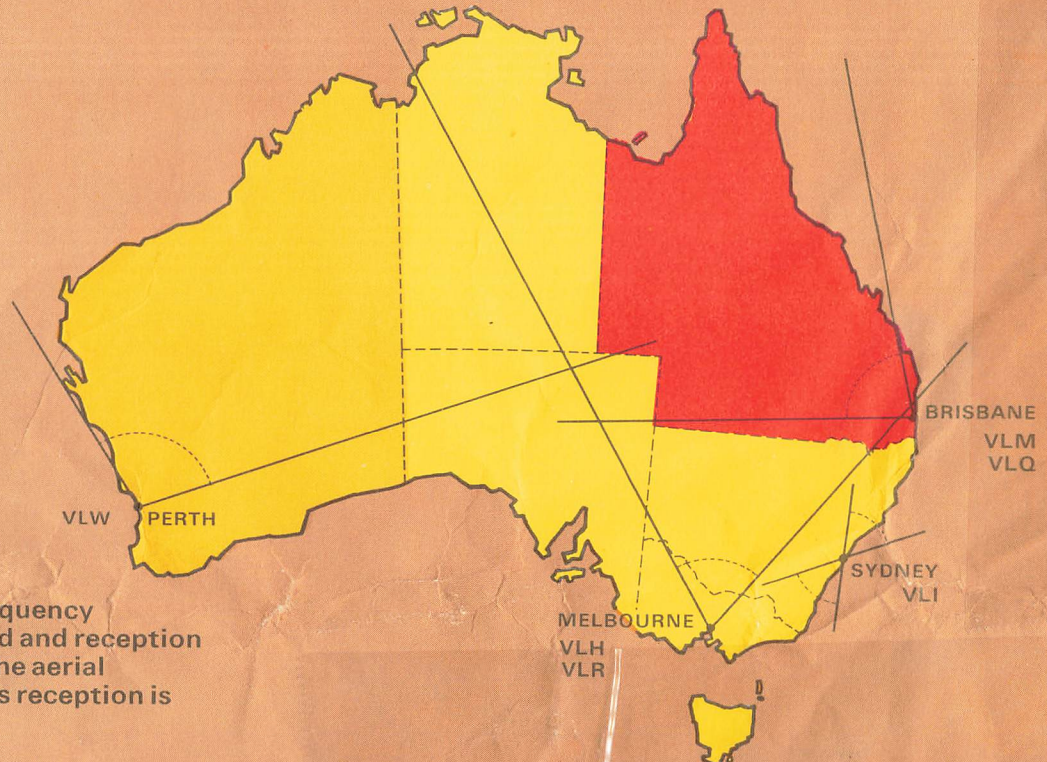

The service areas of the various high frequency transmitters are not precisely delineated and reception quality falls off only gradually outside the aerial beams shown. Within the dotted sectors reception is generally poor owing to the skip effect.
