



CFVP has one of the very few private stations on the short wave band in Canada and has been heard in nearly every country in the world since its installation in 1931. In the spring of 1982, the hand built tube type transmitter was retired and a new Solid State LPB 100 watt transmitter has taken over the duties of CFVP. The program material is presently a rebroadcast of CFCN AM and is fed into a 41 foot (12.3) quarter wave antenna.
