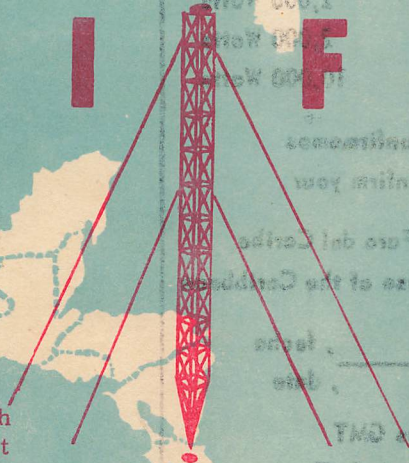

We're so glad you wrote to us! It is always a thrill to hear of another point to which our signal is reaching.

You may be interested in our equipment. On longwave 995 Kcs., we use two 3X2500F3 tubes modulated by another pair putting 10 K. W. into a 240 foot 1/4 wave vertical radiator. On 31 meters (9.645 Mcs.) we are using 833A's with 2 K.W. feeding a modified quad antenna located 1/4 wave length above the ground. On 49 meters (6.037 Mcs.) at present we have a pair of 250TH's modulated by 805's at 500 watts into a centerfed, horizontal, 1/2 wave element, 1/4 wave above the ground. Construction has been started on a 2 K.W. transmitter for 49 meters similar to the unit used on 31 meters.

You may also be interested in Costa Rica, one of the most beautiful countries in the world. We are up 4000 feet in the central plateau, three miles from the capital, San José. Coffee is the principal product up here, bananas on the coast. There are a million people in this little republic, highly literate, ambitious and traditionally democratic. Someday, we hope you can see our 11,000 foot volcanoes and our station TIFC.

We hope, above all, that you are interested in our message. We enjoy presenting good music, mostly classical. On our schedule appear public service, farm and news broadcasts in Spanish. But we are mostly interested in sharing hope and light in this dark world through the facilities of TIFC, "The Lighthouse of the Caribbean". You see, each of us, Latin Americans, U. S. or Canadian citizens, has had something revolutionize our lives. We had no inner peace, no clear purpose in life, no assurance of things beyond the grave. It boiled down to a moral question; the connection between God and our souls had been broken by sin. Then we learned that God, Himself, desired to bring us back to Himself and sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to pay the consequences of our sin. This punishment was effected on the cross. - "The Lord laid on Him the iniquity of us all" - (from Isaiah 53:6, in the Bible). It is up to us to believe and to turn our lives over to Him. We did this one day and our lives have been different since. "As many as received Him (Christ), to them gave He power to become the sons of God. . . to them that believe on His Name" (from John 1:12). We hope you will find the same hope, joy, and forgiveness by putting your faith in Christ Jesus. Please write if we can help you see these things more clearly. That is what we are here for!

You may be interested in our equipment. On January 25, 1952, we
use two 3X2-60P tubes modulated by another pair getting 1.5 W. into a 250
foot 1/4 wave vertical radiator. Our 7.1 meter (9.045 MHz) we are using
833A which is leading a modified quad antenna located 1/4 wave length
above the ground. In 48 meters (6.037 MHz) at present we have a pair of
250TH's modulated by 800's at 500 watts into a center horizontal. Its
wave element. It is above the ground. Construction has been started on
a 3.4 W. transmitter for 48 meters similar to the unit used on 41 meters.



Dear Carl:

Hi! Greetings from your friendly radio station, TIFC, "The Lighthouse of the Caribbean"!

Thank you for your verification report. We are always glad to receive reports from places where our signal is heard.

TIFC, "Faro del Caribe" in Spanish, is located approximately three kilometers from the center of San José, the capital of Costa Rica. This high central area is surrounded by a ring of volcanic mountains. Three of them have erupted within the past 15 years. Costa Rica is sometimes described as "the land of perpetual spring". Coffee and bananas are the main export products. The present population of Costa Rica is nearly two million.

TIFC has five transmitters: the medium wave and 60-meter transmitter with 5,000 watts each using a 3CX2500A3 in the final, with low power stages of the medium wave transistorized; the F.M. Stereo transmitter has an output of 4,000 watts with a six-bay circularly polarized antenna which gives an effective power of 10 Kw, on 97.1 MHz; the 49-meter transmitter has a power of 2.5 Kw, on 6.175 MHz, and the 31-meter transmitter has 500 watts output on 9.645 MHz.

TIFC covers the central plateau of Costa Rica at 1075 kHz on the medium-wave band. The 60-meter (tropical band) transmission on 5.055 MHz covers Costa Rica and Central America. The 49-meter transmitter is well-received in the remote areas of the country. The 31-meter transmitter (500 watts) is often heard outside the country - sometimes long distances away. We receive many encouraging reports from different countries including several reports from Cuba, Japan, Spain and other foreign places.

If there is any further information about our station or about Costa Rica or the message we broadcast, please feel free to write again. We enjoy reading your interesting letters and are happy to answer them as best we can.

Hi! Greetings from your friendly radio station, TICO, "The Lighthouse of the Caribbean!"
Thank you for your verification report. We are always glad to receive reports from places where our signal is heard.

TICO has two transmitters, the medium wave and 60-meter transmitter with 5,000 watts each using a 30K500A5 in the final, with low power stages of the medium wave transmitter; the 60-meter transmitter has an output of 4,000 watts with a 6J5 tube. The 60-meter transmitter has a power of 2.5 kw, on 6.175 mhz, and the 31-meter transmitter has 500 watts output on 9.645 mhz.

TICO covers the central plateau of Costa Rica at 107.7 kHz on the medium-wave band. The 60-meter (proseal band) transmission on 5.055 mhz covers Costa Rica and Central America. The 49-meter transmitter (500 watts) is often heard outside the country. The 31-meter transmitter (500 watts) is often heard outside the country - sometimes long distances away. We receive many encouraging reports from distant countries including several reports from Cuba, Spain and other foreign places.

If there is any further information about our station or about Costa Rica or the message we broadcast, please feel free to write again. We enjoy reading your interesting letters and are happy to answer them as best we can.
