
May God Bless you and we wish you a very blessing 1999.



## Radio Ministry

issionary radio is a major priority in the IMF ministry and 1997, early 1998 has been a time of expansion. In 1997 funds were raised in Honduras for the construction of a new badly needed transmitter building by conducting a radiothon. We want to say thank you to the faithful listeners of this station who sacrificed and made their contribution. In 1997 we were able also to finish the construction of the 160 ft. AM radio tower which allowed our signal over the city and surrounding country to be much stronger. IMF also shipped the new 5 kw shortwave transmitter in late Nov. of 1997 to Tegucigalpa from California.

Brother Planck (who is also a radio engineer) and Pastor Wayne Downs and other workers were able to move all transmitters into our newly completed building and sign on our Shortwave Transmitter Friday night at 9:00PM on Jan. 23, 1998. We immediately were able to be heard in the USA. Many locations and countries have reported in having now heard the station. Praise God! The next phase in the Honduras project is the filing to build

in seven more cities which will become repeaters for the main station in Tegucigalpa.

Other countries are now about to develop as well as we just received word that we will be granted frequencies in Bluefields, Nicaragua. This station will be able to be heard not only in Central America, by all the way into Colombia at night.

Also we are now negotiating for a new AM and Shortwave outlet in Iquitos, Peru which will cover the Amazon River region and South America. Asia is another major target for IMF ministries and our organization has finished it's registration in the Philippines where we are working to obtain several Shortwave frequencies which would allow coverage over all Asia. Why don't you consider becoming part of this outreach to untold multitudes by being a co-laborer financially and prayerfully in the IMF radio ministry.

One Additional note if you have a Shortwave radio you may be able to hear our Honduras (HRMI) station in the evenings. Our frequency is 5890 kHz (5.890 MHZ) in the 49-meter band.



## Missions Report

## **HONDURAS**

he ministry of IMF in this small, but key Central American country has seen much forward progress in 1997 and early 1998. In April of 1997 an outdoor crusade and Pastor/worker seminar was conducted.

During the crusade many scores of people gave their lives to Jesus Christ and many Testimonies of healing miracles took place.

Dr. Vernon and Margareth Falls joined the Planck's in this time of ministry preaching in both the crusade and during the pastor/worker seminar, where many other churches were invited to participate.

Dr. Vernon and Sister Margareth are used by the Holy Spirit in a mighty way in the Prophetic ministry and many were ministered to this way during this special time. These meetings were taped and then played on HRMI (IMF's missionary radio station in Honduras) to be heard by those listening in

Honduras and by Shortwave Radio around the world.

Our director and Senior Pastor Bro. Wayne Downs held a special radiothon in June 1997 on HRMI in which funds were raised to assist in the building of a new transmitter building badly needed to house the AM Transmitter and the new 5Kw Shortwave Transmitter.

This building was moved into Jan. 1998 and the Shortwave Transmitter was installed. Almost immediately reception reports begin to come in from many countries. Other victories included the installation of the 160' AM

radio tower and the c o n t i n u e d development and growth of the Central church.

A second large church is planned to be established in 1998 in the commercial district of Tegucigalpa making it easier for people to come from many parts of the city who are presently listening by radio.

Many new plans are in the works for Honduras. One other note Lifeline International (Dr. Vernon & Margareth Falls) working in cooperation with IMF have established a new Children's Home where 8 abandoned children are now under Christian care.

This being the first of many ministries of this type planned. Become a missionary today by sending your donation.
