

State of Kuwait

Kuwait is a Sovereign Islamic Independent Arab State. It is situated on the north western angle of the Arabian Gulf between latitudes 28° 45, and 30° 5 north, and longitudes 46° and 48° 30, east of Greenwich. The Kuwait Local Time is +3 hours G.M.T. The total area of Kuwait is about 17,818 square Kilometers. It is a flat rolling desert, arid and without any rivers, and rises gradually towards the interior. The climate of Kuwait is tropical.

Kuwait's population according to 1980 census is 1,355,827 (One Million Three Hundred and Fifty Five Thousand, Eight Hundred and Twenty Seven).

Kuwait is the capital of the State of Kuwait. The country is further divided into four towns called Ahmadi, Fahahel, Hawalli and Salmiah. There are also a couple of Islands in Kuwait but the most popular and important from the archaeological point of view is the Failaka Island. The archaeological discoveries in this island date back to the time of Alexander The Great.

Kuwait is a democratic country with a parliamentary type of government, consisting of one house only. There are 50 members in the House who are elected by the people through a secret ballot for a period of four years.

Kuwait celebrates its National Day on February 25.

Education in Kuwait is free and so are the Medical Facilities.

There is no Income or Sales Tax in Kuwait except a very nominal custom duty of 4% on some goods.

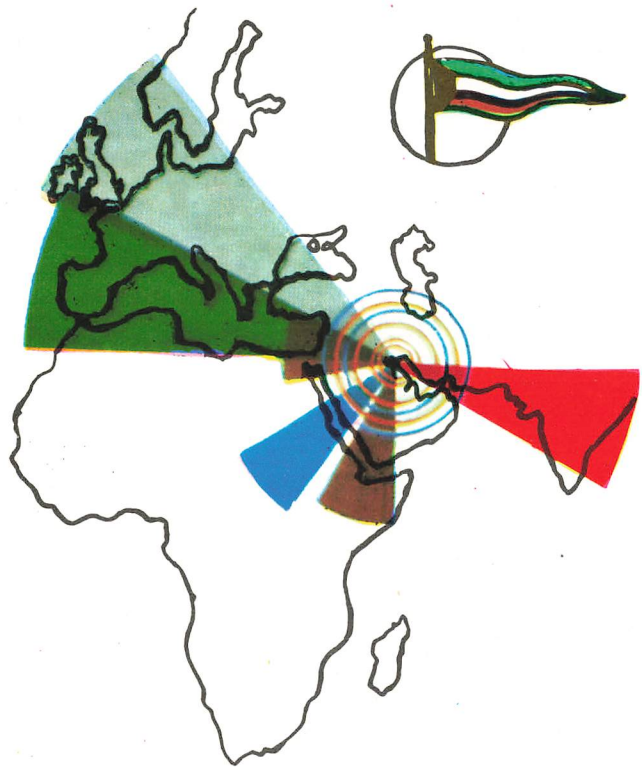
The per capita income in Kuwait is one of the highest in the world and the standard of living is also very high.

The monetary unit of Kuwait is Fils. 1 Kuwaiti Dinar is equal to 1000 Fils. The currency notes are of 10, 5, 1, 1/2, & 1/4 K D denominations and the coins are of 100, 50, 20, 10, 5, & 1 Fil denominations.

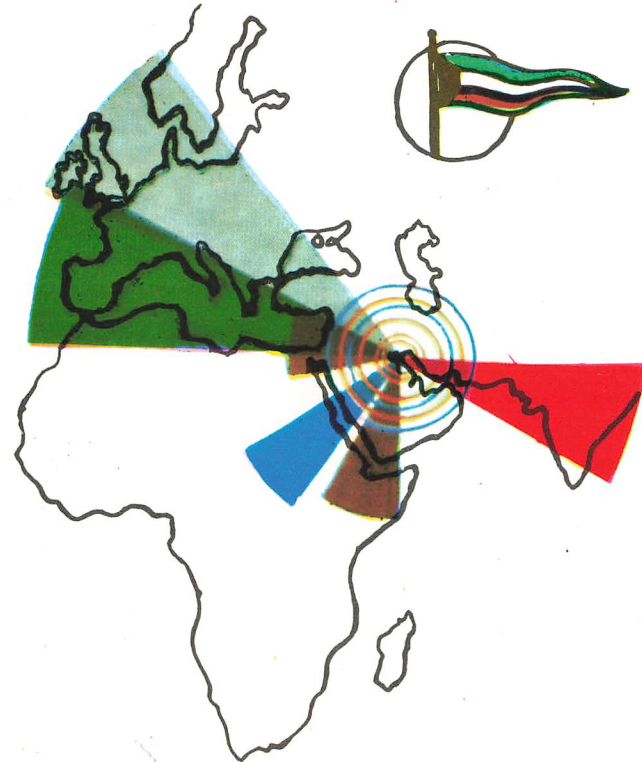

SPOTLIGHT ON THE STATE OF KUWAIT

- Kuwait is an Arab State, independent and fully sovereign. The religion of the State is Islam.
- Kuwait lies at the North West corner of the Arabian Gulf, between latitudes 28° N and 30° N and between longitudes 46° & 48° E. In the North and West it shares a border of 240 Km (149 miles) with the Republic of Iraq, and in the South and South West it shares a border of 250 Km (155 miles) with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. In the East it has a coastline of 290 Km reaching the Arabian Gulf.
- Government: Head of State is H.H. Sheikh Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah, Amir of the State of Kuwait. The Crown Prince and The Prime Minister is H.H. Sheikh Saad Al-Abdallah Al-Salem Al-Sabah. Kuwait is a hereditary Amirate, the succession to which is with the descendants of the late Mubarak Al-Sabah.
- Official Language: Arabic.
- National Day: 25th February.
- Liberation Day: 26th February.
- Local Time: UTC + 3 Hours.
- Climate: Average temperature ranges between 45° C during Summer (in July) and 8° C during winter (in January).
- Population: 1, 712, 133 (1985 Census).
- Area 17, 818 Sq. Km.
- Capital: Kuwait City. Governorates: Ahmadi, Jahra, Hawally, Capital (Kuwait), Farwaniya.
- Currency: The Kuwaiti Dinar. (US\$ 1 = 0.290 fils) (Nov. '92).
- Free education, health services and social security are provided to all citizens.
- Industry: Oil refining, chemical production (ammonia, urea).
- Chief Exports: Petroleum and petroleum products, mineral fuels, lubricants, manufactured fertilizer.
- Chief Imports: Cereals and foodstuffs, heavy machinery, transport equipment, manufactured consumer goods.
- Kuwait is a member of the United Nations Organization, the Arab League, the Gulf Cooperation Council, the Organization of the Islamic Conference and OPEC.
- Grants and Technical Assistance by Kuwait Fund-upto 31 December 1991 amounted to K.D. 1,583 Million.

RADIO KUWAIT

Kuwait became free on 26 February 1991 with the help of God, the Almighty, and by the will of the Kuwaiti people with the support of the Arab and International Community.

Radio Kuwait embarked on the task of reconstruction after the Iraqi invaders had left the country. All Engineers and Technicians were working 24 hours/day, non-stop, in order to bring the voice of Kuwait back on-air.

The actual radio transmissions began on 3 March 1991 giving Main Arabic Programme on FM frequencies 97.5 MHz and 87.9 MHz. Afterwards other transmissions went on-air as the reconstruction process gained momentum.

On 5 March 1991, MW transmission on the frequency 540 KHz giving Main Arabic programme went on-air.

On 6 March 1991, MW transmission on the frequency 1341 KHz giving Main Arabic programme was on-air. Later on various programmes were added for transmission on this frequency.

On 1 June 1991, FM transmission on the frequency 98.9 MHz giving Main Arabic programme and MW transmission on 1134 KHz giving Main Arabic programme were on-air.

On 28 August 1991, FM transmission on 92.5 MHz giving English Stereo Music was started.

It is evident that the Radio Kuwait's staff had put in great efforts in bringing its transmissions back on-air within a short period of time.

Subsequently, Radio Kuwait's staff went on to erect SW transmitters and antennae in order to begin the SW transmissions to various targets.

On 17 February 1992, SW Transmitter No. 1 went on-air giving Main Arabic programme to Gulf, Middle East, Europe and North America.

On 28 March 1992, SW Transmitter No. 2 started its transmissions to cover East & South East Asia, Middle East, Europe & North America giving Main Arabic Programme.

On 17 October 1992, another FM Transmitter was put into service giving various programmes on the frequency 100.2 MHz.

Radio Kuwait is committed to give the best quality transmissions to the people of the State of Kuwait and the world as it was the case before the 2 August 1990 and it is striving to provide even better services incorporating the modern broadcasting technology and equipment.

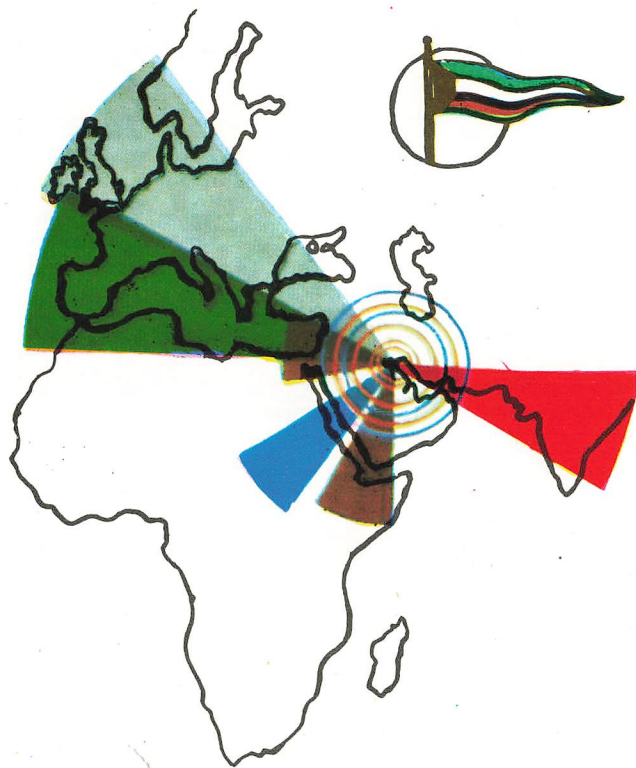

The Oil Refinery in Shuaiba erected by Kuwait National Petroleum Company is said to be the most modern and up to date in the world.

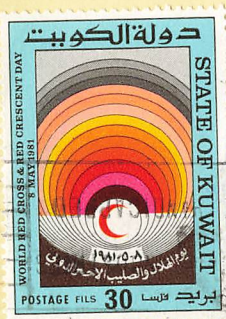

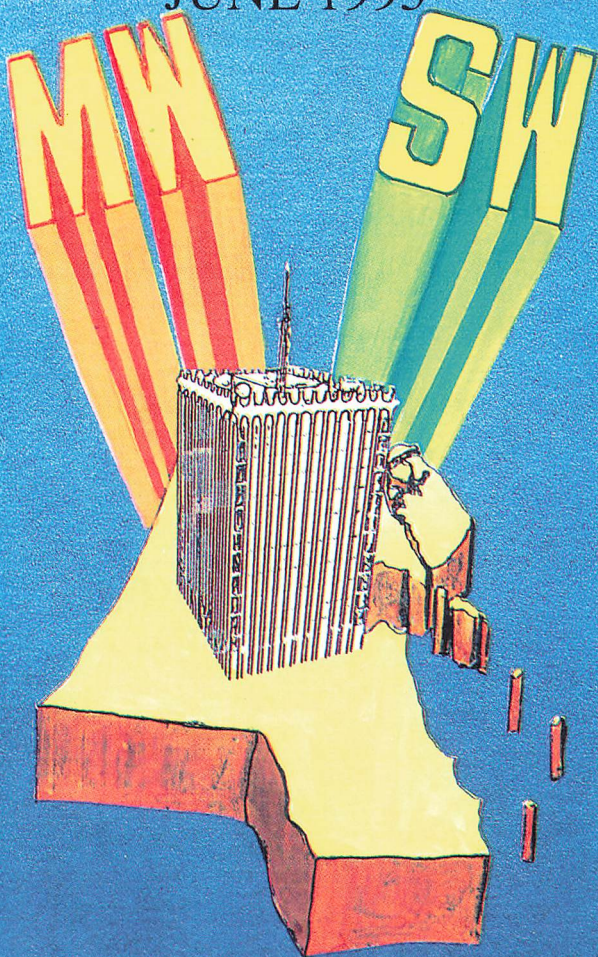

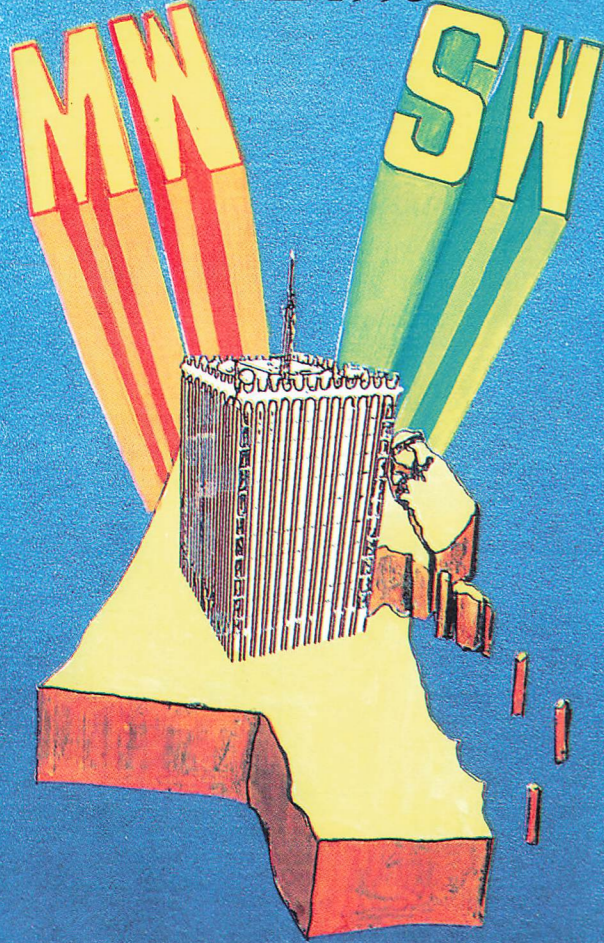
