

## **The Liberty Bell**

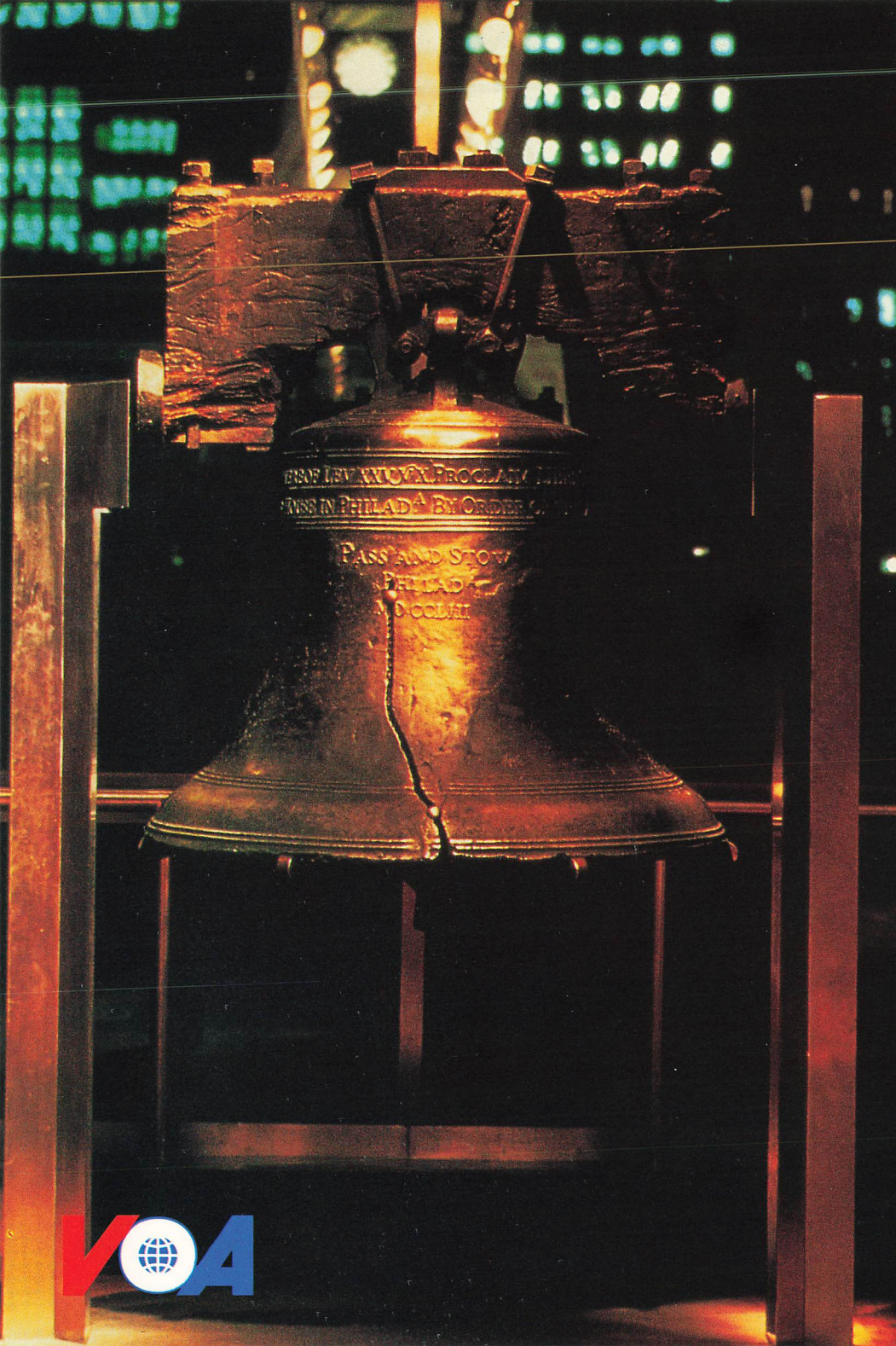

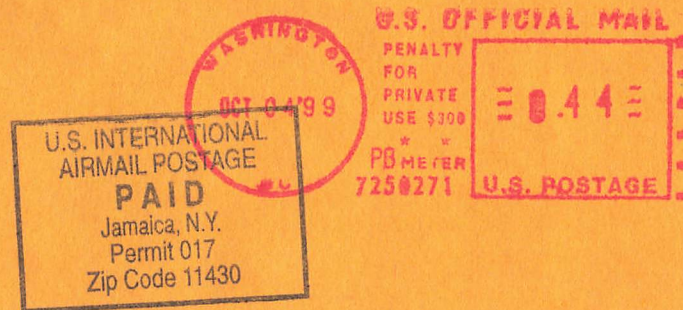
