

AM 725 KCS 50 000 WATTS SW 4850 KCS 10 000 WATTS FM STEREO 96.4 MCS 2000 WATTS Radio SRS, a government owned station, was founded in 1965. We transmit on three frequencies: 725 Kcs 50 Kw AM transmitter, 96.4 Mcs 2000 Watt FM Stereo transmitter en 10 Kw SW transmitter on 4850 Kcs. Our main purpose is to serve the local population with news, music and other entertainment and educational programs. We broadcast daily from 05.30 a.m. till 01.00

a.m. (local time)
The SW transmitter closes down at 22.00 hrs (local time)
During some times of the day we do a separate program
(SRS II) on FM Stereo for local listeners who prefer good
music to long information programs.

Our first programm (SRS I) is also broadcast on a small FM mono transmitter (10 watts) om 93.1 Mcs.

We have a total amount of 26 full time employees in our service and another 26 part time workers in different fields. Suriname is situated in the northern part of South America and is bounded on the north by the Atlantic, to the west Guyana, to the east French Guyana and to the
