Radio Station "Peace and Progress" was founded in 1964 by Soviet public organisations. Among its sponsors are the Union of Soviet Societies for Friendship and Cultural Ties with Foreign Countries, the Soviet Peace Committee, the Soviet Writers' Union, the Soviet Journalists' Union, the Soviet Women's Committee and the Soviet Committee of Youth Organisations.

Radio Station "Peace and Progress" broadcasts daily in eleven languages, including the Chinese language. Broadcasts in Chinese are conducted for listeners in the People's Republic of China (in the Peking, Shanghai and Canton dialects) and in South-East Asia (in the Peking dialect). For regions in South and South-East Asia, English language programs are also transmitted.

By regularly listening to these broadcasts, you will be able to obtain detailed information on the foreign policy course of the Soviet Union, various aspects in the Soviet way of life, a clear and concise picture of Soviet-Chinese relations, as well as many other questions.

We frequently carry interviews and statements of Soviet citizens as well as public functionaries from other countries.

Radio Station "Peace and Progress" replies to listeners' questions in our broadcasts as well as by mail. Their remarks and suggestions are duly heeded in preparing our transmissions.
