
I wish to confirm your report of hearing Radio Station ZIZ St. Kitts on December 5th 1970 on 585 Kilo hertz from 9.40 to 11.01 St. Kitts time 0140 to 0301 GMT. with a signal strength ranging from poor to fairly good.

Our transmitting facilities consist of S.T.C. (Australia) 5 Kw transmitter feeding a top loaded T antenna. Supported by two masts 160ft high and 400ft apart. Our transmitting facilities are situated on a hill 1000ft above Sea level and some 4 miles from our studios. We Broadcast 17 hours daily, that is from 6.00 a. m. to 11.00 p. m.

Our assigned operating frequency is 570Khz., but because of strong interference we have been carrying out some tests on 585 Khz. We therefore welcome your reception report very much; also the tape which enabled us to hear what we sound like to DX listeners.

We hope to hear from you again.
