We are pleased to confirm that you did receive Radio Trinidad at the times quoted.

Radio Trinidad operates on an assigned frequency of 730 Kc/s in the broadcast band with a power of 20 Kw., consisting of two Redifon G162 transmitters, operated in parallel via a "T" network and feeding a "T" antenna 180' in height. We also operate on 95.1 Mc/s in the FM band carrying the identical programmes.

Our M.W. transmitters are located at Caroni, about ten miles from Port of Spain, the capital of Trinidad, and the FM is sited at Cumberland Hill 1,080 feet above sea level.

We wish you lots of luck in your Dx. hunt.
