
Thank you very much for your good reception report concerning reception of HCJB on 700 kHz during our special DX broadcast on the 14th of December 1970. We appreciate the effort you made to listen to this program in spite of the very early hour at which it was broadcast.

After checking your report with the log made during the broadcast, we are certain that you were listening to our transmission. We are sorry that the reception wasn't better and that there was considerable interference from such stations as WLW, TIHB and others that were also operating on the same frequency or close by. Several reports mentioned hearing tones at various times during the broadcast. These probably were from KBTR in Denver which we understand was on the air during the entire hour of our program on 710 kHz. They were testing and using various test tones. We did not have any such material on our program.

We are very happy to be able to send you a QSL card confirming your reception of this special DX broadcast. However, due to recent increases in postage rates and changes in postal regulations here in Ecuador, we are sending you this card under separate cover. We trust you will receive it in the near future.

It was a pleasure for us here at HCJB to be able to present this special release at the request of Larry Godwin and the International Radio Club of America. We are glad that so many were able to pick us up and add HCJB to their list of verified medium-wave stations.

- We wish to thank you for your reception report. We have found it correct and hereby acknowledge with this verification card.


